

PRIVACY POLICY

WE VALUE YOUR PRIVACY

Supersize Inc. (“Supersize,” “Company,” “we,” “us,” or “our”) values your privacy. This Privacy Policy (“Policy”) explains how we collect, use, and share certain information or data from users. This Policy is incorporated by reference into our Terms of Use. By agreeing to this Policy and by continuing to use the Service, you agree to the terms of this Policy. In this Policy, unless specifically defined herein, any capitalized terms have the meanings given to them in our Terms of Use.

WHAT TYPE OF DATA WE COLLECT

We do not create or manage traditional user accounts, and we do not gather or retain data such as your name unless you voluntarily provide it. Interactions with the Interface may result in the collection of the following limited data (“Data”):

- **Public Blockchain Data:** When you connect your non-custodial blockchain wallet to the Interface, we may capture and record your publicly visible blockchain address. This allows us to analyze engagement and conduct wallet screening for potential prior illicit activity using insights from reputable blockchain analytics firms. Blockchain addresses are inherently public and are generated independently; neither we nor any central authority creates or assigns them, and they do not inherently identify individuals.
- **Data from Third-Party Sources:** To fulfill legal requirements and mitigate fraud or illicit use of the Services, we may engage service providers who may obtain details about your wallet address or Service-related transactions.
- **Survey and Usability Data:** If you participate in a survey or usability study, we may document biographical details you voluntarily share (such as your name, email address, or job title), your responses, and your engagement.
- **Communications Data:** We may retain messages or details you submit directly through email, social media, or other channels, including responses from surveys or questionnaires.
- **Voluntarily Provided Information:** If you choose to share specific details, such as your email address, we may use them solely for the purposes described at the time of submission. We will not attempt to correlate such information with your wallet address, IP address, or other personal identifiers. Providing personal data is entirely optional and is not required to access or use the Services.
- **Cookies and Similar Technologies:** We may collect information through automated means such as cookies, web beacons, and web server logs. By using the Service, you consent to the placement and use of cookies, beacons, and similar technologies in accordance with this Policy.

HOW WE USE THE DATA WE COLLECT

- Providing, maintaining, customizing, and improving the Services and their features.
- Understanding and analyzing usage trends and improving the Service.
- Protecting against, investigating, and stopping fraudulent, unauthorized, or illegal activity.
- Addressing security risks, resolving bugs or other security issues, and protecting users and the protocol.
- Complying with legal and regulatory requirements.
- Enforcing the Terms of Use and other legal rights.

WHEN AND WITH WHOM WE SHARE THE DATA WE COLLECT

We do not rent, sell, or share your Data with third parties except as described in this Policy. We may share your Data with the following:

- Service providers that assist with website hosting, data analysis, email delivery, and other services that support the provision, delivery, and improvement of the Services.
- Potential or actual acquirers, successors, assignees, or other entities in connection with any reorganization, merger, sale, joint venture, assignment, transfer, disposition, bankruptcy, or similar proceeding.
- Governmental, regulatory, law enforcement, or other authorities when required by law, legal process, subpoena, court order, or other valid legal procedure, or when we believe disclosure is appropriate to protect our rights, operations, users, or others.
- Parties involved in litigation, regulatory proceedings, compliance measures, or dispute resolution where disclosure is reasonably necessary.
- Third parties where we believe sharing is necessary to prevent harm to Slimecoin: Play for Cash, its users, or others, or to enforce our agreements and policies.
- Third parties assisting with fraud prevention, security, unauthorized activity detection, bug resolution, or protection of the Slimecoin: Play for Cash ecosystem.
- Any other party when you provide your consent.

ANALYTICS

We may use third-party analytics vendors to evaluate and provide us with information about use of the Service. These analytics providers may set and access their own cookies, pixel tags, and similar technologies on the Service, and they may otherwise collect or have access to data about you over time and across different websites. For example, we may use Google Analytics to collect and process certain analytics data. Google provides additional privacy options through its own published privacy materials.

We may also use and disclose aggregate data that does not identify and cannot reasonably be linked to an individual for any lawful purpose, unless prohibited by applicable law.

THIRD-PARTY SERVICES AND SITES

We may display third-party content on the Service. Third-party content may use cookies, web beacons, or other mechanisms to obtain data in connection with your viewing of or interaction with that content.

You should be aware that there is always some risk involved in transmitting data over the internet. While we strive to protect your Data, we cannot ensure or warrant the security or privacy of data or other content you transmit using the Service, and you do so at your own risk.

We cannot control and are not responsible for data collected and processed by third parties, their safekeeping of such data, any breach involving such data, or their compliance with applicable privacy laws or regulations. We encourage you to review the privacy policy of any third party you interact with and to use your own judgment.

We may incorporate third-party technologies or features into certain aspects of the Services, such as hyperlinks to external websites, platforms, or resources that are not owned or managed by us. If you engage with those third parties, they may independently gather data about you and request additional information. To understand their data practices, please review the privacy policies and terms applicable to those third parties.

HOW WE PROTECT YOUR DATA

We implement and maintain reasonable administrative, physical, and technical safeguards designed to protect Data from loss, theft, misuse, unauthorized access, disclosure, alteration, and destruction. Nevertheless, internet transmission is not completely secure, and we cannot guarantee the security of Data about you. You are responsible for all activity on the Interface, including the security of your blockchain addresses, cryptocurrency

wallets, and cryptographic keys.

You acknowledge that no transmission of data over the internet is completely secure. While we strive to protect your Data, we cannot ensure or warrant the security or privacy of data or other content you transmit using the Service, and you do so at your own risk.

HOW LONG WE KEEP YOUR DATA

We will retain your Data for as long as necessary to provide the Services and as necessary to comply with our legal obligations, resolve disputes, and enforce our policies. Retention periods will be determined based on the type of Data collected, the purpose for which it was collected, applicable legal requirements, and the need to delete outdated or unused Data within a reasonable time.

DISCLOSURES FOR EUROPEAN UNION DATA SUBJECTS

We process your Data for the purposes described in the section titled “HOW WE USE THE DATA WE COLLECT” above. Our legal bases for processing may include: (i) your consent for one or more specific purposes; (ii) processing necessary for the performance of a contract with you; (iii) processing necessary for compliance with a legal obligation; and/or (iv) processing necessary for the legitimate interests pursued by us or a third party, where those interests are not overridden by your rights and freedoms.

Your rights under the General Data Protection Regulation may include the right to: (i) request access to and obtain a copy of your personal data; (ii) request rectification or erasure of your personal data; (iii) object to or request restriction of the processing of your personal data; and (iv) request portability of your personal data. You may also withdraw your consent at any time. However, we cannot edit or delete data stored on a blockchain. Information such as transaction data, blockchain wallet addresses, and assets associated with a blockchain address may be beyond our control.

NO USE OF SERVICES BY MINORS

CROSS-BORDER DATA TRANSFERS

Your Data may be transferred to, stored in, and processed in countries other than your country of residence. By using the Service, you consent to the transfer of Data to countries that may have data protection rules different from those of your country.

We may update this Policy from time to time. If we make material changes, we may notify you through the Service. We encourage you to review this Policy periodically to stay informed about our privacy practices. By continuing to access or use the Service after revisions become effective, you agree to the updated Policy.
